Job Summary

This position provides psychological services to assigned clients at Community Addiction Recovery Enterprise. Services include psychological evaluation, client education, group and individual psychotherapy and participation in treatment planning.

Primary Duties Include:

- Providing psychological assessment services
- Providing clinical treatment services including Integrated Dual Disorders approaches through individual and group psychotherapy, family therapy and/or psychoeducation.
- Acting as a consultant to the unit treatment team with responsibility for providing leadership in the treatment team process
- Providing expertise, training and ongoing support of clinical staff in the engagement and treatment of individuals with chronic mental illness and dually diagnosed MI/CD using Evidenced Based Practices

Minimum Qualifications

To qualify, you must have:

- a Master's degree in Psychology or closely related field in an accredited program,
- MN licensure as a Professional Licensed Psychologist (LP), Licensed Psychological Practitioner (LPP), Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT), Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC), or Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC).

OR

- a PhD in Psychology or closely related field in an accredited program.

NOTE: License eligible psychologists can be hired as a Psychologist 2 on a provisional appointment.

And per MN Statutes, you must

- be at least 18 years old,
- be able to pass a criminal background check, and

- sign a statement attesting that you have been free of chemical use problems for at least two years immediately preceding hire.

REFERENCE/BACKGROUND CHECKS - The Department of Human Services will conduct reference checks to verify job-related credentials and criminal background check prior to appointment.
