The LRE is looking for a **Chief Financial Officer** to be responsible for the process of managing revenues and expenditures to provide accountability to management and funders, to maximize financial resources, and maintain fiscal integrity for the Lakeshore Regional Entity (LRE). The CFO serves as the financial liaison for the region and is the interface between the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and Community Mental Health Service Providers (CMHSP) of the LRE for all behavioral health and substance use disorder funding received by the LRE.

A Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Finance, Business Administration or a related field with at least 5 years' accounting management experience in mental health or behavioral health is required; a Masters' degree is preferred. A thorough understanding of generally accepted accounting practices, procedures, and standards, Michigan Mental Health Code, Balanced Budget Act of 1997, and an extensive and demonstrated knowledge of behavioral health funding streams, including but not limited to Medicaid State Plan, B(3), and C-Waiver is a must.
